Product: Eight group vision statements

- One statement that is consensus choice of group (at least one sentence but no more than four);
- 2. also include other words and phrases that should be part of it;

E. Small Group Work

30 min.

- 1. Chose one person to guide the small group discussion
- 2. Choose one person to record small group work and chart
- 3. Each person in the group reads their Vision Statement and the whole group listens carefully
- 4. Chose "one" as a STARTER vision statement.
- 5. Write the STARTER Vision Statement on the 81/2"x11" colored paper or on chart paper.
- Small group ADDS, DELETES, CHANGES the STARTER Vision Statement to create a Vision Statement that reflects the best thinking and agreements of the small group.
- 7. Make note of other words and phrases that the group thought were important, but did not get worked in the vision statement.
- 8. Recorder writes Small Group's Vision Statement on flichart paper to share with the

large group and decide who will report out to the whole group (2 min./group)
