1. Proposed Adoption of New Chapters 211, 212, 213 and 214, Title 15, Hawaii Administrative Rules, Relating to Rules for Kewalo Basin

The Department of Transportation-Harbors will relinquish jurisdiction of Kewalo Basin on June 30, 2007. Establishing Rules, Regulations, Charges and Fees for Kewalo Basin will govern the use and operation of Kewalo Basin under the jurisdiction, management, and operation of the Hawaii Community Development Authority. These rules are considered necessary and desirable to facilitate the public's use and enjoyment of Kewalo Basin. The Rules define permissible activities, regulate operations within the harbor and set forth procedures for obtaining leases and related fees, if applicable.

New Chapter 211 of Title 15, HAR relates to Kewalo Basin Rules for Kewalo Harbor and Tariff

New Chapter 212 of Title 15, HAR relates to Vessel and Harbor Controls

New Chapter 213 of Title 15, HAR relates to Kewalo Basin Rules for Motor Vehicles

New Chapter 214 of Title 15, HAR relates to Kewalo Basin Rules Relating to Services and Procedures, Charges, Tolls and Fees

Note: Based on meetings with task force members and tenants, certain provisions in the rules were modified from the draft rules that were approved for public hearing by the Governor. Proposed revised rules are available at www.hcdaweb.org.

2. Proposed Amendments to Chapter 15-210 Rules, Regulations, Charges, and Fees for Public Parks

Amending Rules, Regulations, Charges and Fees for Public Parks will update the use and protection of all parks under the jurisdiction, management, and operation of the Hawaii Community Development Authority, providing passive and active, cultural, educational and commercial activities for the well being and safety of all who visit the area. These rules are considered necessary and desirable to facilitate the public's use and enjoyment of the Public Parks. The Amendments clarify permissible activities and establish a fee schedule for commercial park usage.
